

**VILLAGE OF EPHRAIM  
ORDINANCE NO. 02-2016  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE OF EPHRAIM ZONING CODE AS IT RELATES TO  
EXCLUDED USES**

**SECTION I:** § 17.16(10) of the Ephraim Code of Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting as follows:

**DELETIONS CROSSED OUT**

**17.16 STANDARDS FOR SPECIFIC USES.**

**(10) EXCLUDED USES; ALL DISTRICTS.**

The following activities are specifically prohibited within the Village:

~~(a) — The manufacture, distribution or sale of alcohol or fermented malt beverages. No person shall carry or expose to view any open can, bottle, glass or other container containing fermented malt beverage or intoxicating liquor, or drink from the same, on any public street, walk or alley, or any public way in the Village of Ephraim. Further, when alcoholic beverages are consumed in a publicly owned building associated with a municipal property, consumption must be confined to the building and a permit must be obtained prior to the event, including proof of liquor liability insurance. (12/10/01)~~

**SECTION II:** If any section, subsection, paragraph or sentence of this ordinance is for any reason deemed unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.

**SECTION III:** This ordinance, as an amendment to the Village Zoning Code, has been reviewed by that Plan Committee on May 23, 2016, published as a class B notice in the Door County Advocate on June 4, 2016 and June 8, 2016 and was the subject of a public hearing on June 14, 2016, pursuant to the procedures of § 62.23 (d) Wis. Stats and § 17.51 Ephraim Zoning Code.

**SECTION IV.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law on July 1, 2016.
