

VILLAGE OF EPHRAIM
ORDINANCE NO. 05 -2016
AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE USE OF SPLIT SHIFTS DURING ELECTIONS

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Village Board of Trustees on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 sets of officials to work at different times on each Election Day as follows:

SECTION I: The Village Board hereby authorizes the Clerk to select two or more sets of election officials from those duly appointed to work at different times on election days; and the first shift shall commence at 6:30 a.m. and end at 2 p.m. The second shift shall commence at 2 p.m. and end with completion of all required Election Day duties that follow the closure of the polls. In the event the Clerk cannot find enough inspectors to fill 2 shifts, the Clerk may then elect to have one or more inspectors work all day.

SECTION 2: If political parties submit lists to the Village for appointment of election officials pursuant to Sec. 7.30 (4) (c) Wis. Stats., the Clerk shall choose election officials in such a manner that the local number of officials is an odd number.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law on November 15, 2016.
